



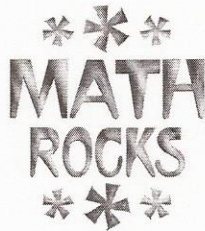

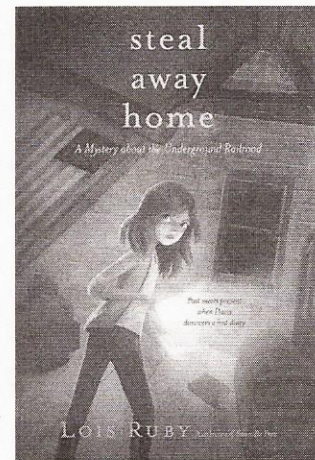
Math

Science

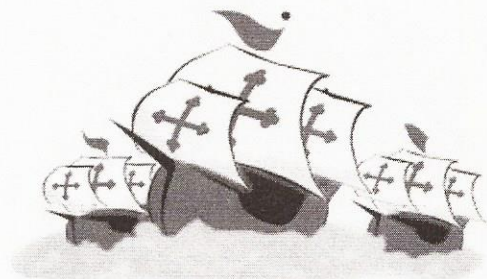
We will continue our Earth Science unit on space. This week we will focus on stars and how we study them in the night sky.

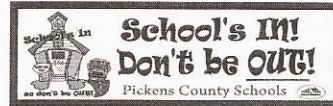
