## Math

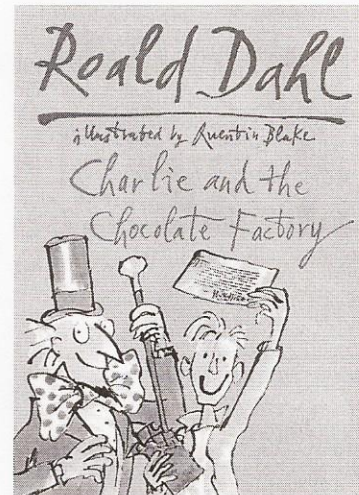
- This week we will continue to understand and solve problems with multiplicative comparison. We will then explore factors, multiples, and prime numbers

Please study multiplication facts at home!!! It is very important to have multiplication facts memorized before we move into division.



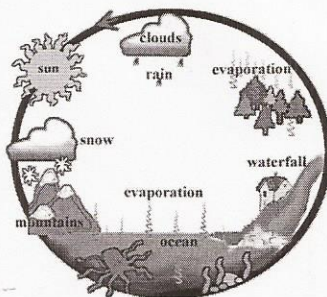
## Reading
